GRACE -PART 2

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Grace as we saw in Part 1 is a unlimited, spiritual gift from God to merit His favour, Grace and a transformation of attitudes, behaviors, situations, and challenges. Something impossible becomes possible.

Many years ago, I was in a very difficult situation. My husband Joe had fallen and fractured his neck. He had to have a halo brace fixed to his brain for 4 months, lie down 24 hours on an easy chair 45 degrees and could not even sleep on the bed. Had to be helped in every way and the halo brace 1) Screws had to be cleaned every day and the nurse from RDNS would come to do this (One dust particle in the screws I was warned could cause paralysis). 2) Had to be gently taken to the Alfred Hospital to have a shower and change the fur on which the halo brace rested on his shoulders amongst many other daily chores.

While this was all very difficult and inconvenient for him, it also made my life impossible. Especially as I could not go out leaving him unattended. He had already very difficult attitudes with what life had dealt with him with many betrayals. Losses and disappointments in life. He refused to go to rehab, refused the help of the two carers who were sent to help him as well as me.

Ps Lucky the senior Pastor from CLA -where both were worshipping sent lunch and dinner for 3 weeks and would have happily sent for more weeks -but Joe would none of this and wanted me to cook and look after him -all by myself. I felt trapped, resentful and was getting very offended with this situation.

But deep down, I knew it was wrong, wrong, and wrong to be angry and offended -to look after a very sick and helpless man/ however difficult he made it for me. It was not the Christian thing at all. I became depressed and went to the Dr .to help me to be cheerful and good about my current task. The antidepressant only made me sick, dizzy, and vomitish.

Two nights of this, I threw the antidepressant tablets, fell on my knees and confessed to God - of my very wrong attitude. I had known about Grace and so I cried for Grace to tide me over. Guess what? The next day I felt better and the second day I woke up like a young bride, happily did all the tasks cheerfully cooked not only the 3 main meals but tried out new recipes and did everything else so lovingly. The next few months were the happiest I had experienced for many years.

The consequences of this Grace in my life? It was Obedience and submission to God in this challenge.

- 1) Every evening as I tucked Joe into his easy chair to sleep after a lovely dinner and got into my bed myself to read and pray-God gave me the blueprint for an Inner Healing Manuel. Soon After Jesuran Healing Ministry was established.
- 2) Joe who had stopped praying aloud would say a few words of prayer every now and then. I could see his soul was at peace despite his extenuating difficult and uncomfortable situation and life. (A happy wife is a tonic and healing to a sick husband and vice versa)
- 3) God gave Joe a 180-degree full healing after 4 months at the age of 74 and I saw him with a mamoty a few days later in the garden.!!!!
- 4) A practical lesson to experience to have, share and teach so many clients that Grace is a spiritual gift that could be asked (even though it is a sovereign gift at God's Grace & Mercy -most of the times)
- 5) Grace is a real gift to operate impossible matters into possibility and find joy and peace even in difficult, demanding, arduous challenges.

Cry out for GRACE tonight and all the nights you find yourself in impossible relationships, impossible challenges and impossible unforgiveness to people who do not merit your forgiveness-the key to Inner Healing.
