- 1) **In everything he undertook, he sought his God and worked wholeheartedly** -2 Chronicles 31:21

- 2) **A change in lifestyle** -breaking away from family traditions and rituals. Leaving family moulds that are not positive.

- 3) **Loneliness**-How he dealt with this very dangerous emotion by turning to God than developing strongholds of addictions, buying things to fill the gap within, seeking people at any cost to take away the lonely hours.

- 4) **Criticism** – When you do something different and noble -you are sure to face this attack of words against you. Learn to turn a deaf ear

and seek the delight of only God. Keep smiling a blessing on those who despise you.

5) **Hard work & Money** – Learn to give up time, energy, and money to reach your goal.

6) **Daily discipline** – Set aside time to worship, read your word and pray-It pays dividends.

7) **Constant Pressure** – People expect you to provide results, especially if they donate money. God has His own time timetable. Just TRUST Him and have faith. God will come through.

The principles Hezekiah used worked for him, are working for me (work in progress) and will work for you-my dear dear people of God's love.
