
GRACE



What is God's Grace? The grace of God is the **unmerited**, **undeserved**, **and unearned favour of God upon us**. Despite us having sinned against God, He still loves, accepts, adopts, and forgives us as believers. That's His grace. God's grace saves us, justifies us, and redeems us. Grace is a gift from God.

What does Grace mean in the Bible?

In Christian terms, grace can be generally defined as "God's favor toward the unworthy" or "God's benevolence on the undeserving." In His grace, God is willing to forgive us and bless us, even though we fall short of living righteously.

Why is God's Grace important?
