# FREE MOBILE MEDICAL CAMP




## "Community Care in Action: Free Mobile Medical Camp by Jesuran Aravanaikkum Karam Brings Healing to Achchelu"

She was running a beauty parlor, but due to opposition from many people, including black magic, witchcraft, and sorcery, she was forced to shut down her business. The impact of these dark forces has disrupted her family, leaving them without peace and forcing them to lead a life full of suffering.

She is currently under severe mental stress and continues to face many challenges within her family. Additionally, she is also taking care of her elderly parents. Due to such difficult circumstances, she was unable to meet us directly. Therefore, our staff provided her with emotional and mental support through telephone-based counseling services.

Lishani was deceived into marriage without her consent. Her husband did not engage in any work or make any effort to support the family. Additionally, he had bad habits such as alcohol addiction, suspicion, and using harsh language. He treated Lisa very poorly by physically abusing and harassing her, causing severe mental and physical suffering.



He completely took away all of Lishani's property and squandered it entirely. Once everything was gone, he abandoned her and left. Currently, Lishani is caught in a divorce case. Her son, as a result of his father's actions, is living a life filled with severe mental distress and fear.

Furthermore, Lisa's daughter, Sanjith, was born with a hole in her heart. She underwent surgery at Colombo National Hospital and is now slowly recovering. The debts Lisa incurred for her son's medical expenses, combined with the family's financial struggles, have left her under immense pressure.

The harsh suffering from her past experiences has deeply wounded Lisa, forcing her to live a life filled with pain and distress. Prayers and ministry were conducted for Lisa and her daughter Sanjitha to bring them healing and peace.

Now, Safeena is responsible for her younger siblings—a 19-year-old sister and an 11-year-old brother. After their mother's death, her grandmother and uncle initially took them in but have since declared that they are unable to care for them any longer and asked them to leave the house.

Despite still having limited functionality in one hand, Shabeena has been doing her best to take up jobs outside and provide for her siblings. This has caused her immense mental stress, and she continues to struggle with severe poverty. Recognizing her situation, our staff identified Safeena and have been offering her emotional support and counseling. They have been continuously caring for her to this day.

However, recently, the son who was always loving towards his mother has completely stopped talking to her and has even started hating her.

The elder son still speaks to her, but the bond of affection they once had is no longer the same. In this situation, the elder son now wishes to live with his father, while the younger son has stated that he does not want either parent. Due to this, Sharmila is deeply heartbroken and distressed. Inner healing ministry has been provided to comfort her.
