In the past month of February, a sister named Darshini came to us due to family problems. She is originally from the Paruthithurai area of Jaffna. Her husband is from Trincomalee. After their marriage, they had been living in Trincomalee. However, due to her husband's disorderly conduct and irresponsible lifestyle, Darshini was deeply affected emotionally. As a result of frequent disagreements, she separated from her husband and returned to her hometown, Paruthithurai, along with their one-year-old son.



They come from a very poor background and were living below the poverty line. Due to these difficult circumstances, Darshini had to marry at a young age. Now, with her married life in question, she had become mentally distressed and was often found in a confused state of mind, sometimes even exhibiting signs of aggression towards her one-year-old son. In this situation, we continuously ministered to her inner healing and encouraged her through prayer. We also worked to reconnect her with her husband, counseling him to correct his ways and striving to reunite the family. As a result of these efforts, on the 14th of April, Darshini and her husband were reconciled and she was able to return to Trincomalee to continue her family life. We give all glory to God who granted such a wonderful grace.

Sudharvizhi, aged 40, she has been experiencing continuous tearing from both eyes. At times, a pus-like discharge also comes out along with the tears, causing her intense pain in her eyes. Although she has taken medication prescribed by doctors, the condition has not completely healed and still persists.



She also mentioned that her three daughters are facing many problems in their lives. Additionally, she suffers from severe pain in her hip area. These issues have caused her significant mental distress. An inner healing ministry was conducted for her

## A Mother's Silent Struggle

Selvi, aged 50, has three daughters. Her third daughter was affected by a cell attack, which left her unable to hear and unable to walk. In addition, when going out to public places, she suddenly experiences seizures. Her daughter's condition has caused Selvi a great deal of mental distress. An inner healing ministry was conducted for her.



## Supporting Journey to Well-being and Independence

Dhanushiya is 21 years old.

She has completed her A/L (Advanced Level) studies and is currently staying at home.

She has a desire to work, but her parents do not permit her to go out.

Additionally, she is worried about her weight, as it is not appropriate for her age.

Because of this, she remains at home under a lot of pressure and is seen to be depressed.

A counseling intervention was carried out for her well-being.



## Journey of Faith, Challenges, and Inner Healing

Dharshi is 35 years old. She is originally from the Colombo area. After receiving God's call, she moved to Thaitti to serve as a pastor. Her husband remains in Colombo for work purposes, and they have a three-year-old son.

Although she is faithfully ministering in this new place, facing new experiences and challenges, it became evident to us that she is carrying inner struggles. Therefore, an inner healing ministry was conducted for her.

Abishalini is 20 years old. Due to a hormonal issue, she is facing various physical problems. As a result, she is experiencing a lot of emotional distress. An inner healing ministry was conducted for her.



## **Prioritizing Health and Hope**

Chandrakala is 50 years old. She often experiences dizziness and worries that she might have a serious illness.

Additionally, she is concerned about her increasing body weight.

A counseling intervention was carried out for her well-being.



## **Recovery and a New Beginning**

Sharon is 16 years old. Due to mental confusion, she dropped out of school and is now staying alone at home.

Additionally, she has become addicted to mobile phone usage.

Although she has now expressed a desire to return to school, she has not yet fully recovered.

Moreover, the school administration has not yet expressed willingness to re-admit her.


In this situation, a counseling intervention was carried out for her healing.
