

FREE MEDICAL CAMP



Hope Awakens in Vayavilan, A Healing Touch for Body and Soul

Suthanthirapuram Vayavilan village (Division: J/244) is a small community deeply affected by poverty and social challenges. Approximately 150-200 families live here, with a total population of around 500. Among them, there are about 80-100 children under the age of 18. There are also about 15 people with disabilities and 15-20 widows in the village. Basic needs such as clean water, housing, sanitation, and education are severely lacking. Most residents are engaged in daily wage labor, resulting in very low household income. Alcoholism, substance abuse, and betel chewing are widespread among both children and adults. Educational attainment is extremely low, and due to the lack of value placed on education by parents, many children drop out of school at an early age to join their parents at work.

With no access to proper healthcare, many physical ailments remain untreated. Social behavior, communication skills, and discipline are at a very low level. Despite the existence of various services and facilities, the people of this village have been living a generational lifestyle of bondage without making efforts to utilize them.

On June 10, 2025, we visited this area through the compassionate outreach of Jesuran to conduct a medical camp. Our doctor, Dr. Alfred Cruz, along with nurse Mohan, rendered excellent service. A total of 76 individuals, from children to the elderly, attended the camp.

But healing went beyond the physical. Our team ministered through prayer and inner healing. We laid hands on the sick, spoke words of life, and declared hope over the land. Tears flowed—not only because of physical illness, but as hearts began to release pain and receive peace.

This camp was more than a humanitarian effort—it was a prophetic act, declaring that Vayavilan is not forgotten. God is mindful of this land and its people. Seeds of healing—both physical and spiritual—have been sown here

From Deep Grief to Healing Hope


