JAK continues to run the Jaffna Inner Healing Ministry with minimal supervision, learning to lean on God, catching the vision for Jaffna and the Northern Province, and being anointed as Joshuas.

They continue to provide inner healing to clients both at the Centre, in the villages they visit and over the phone—especially to those who live far away or cannot afford transport.


Meanwhile, I have been working on a succession plan, ministry partnerships, and funding for the Mobile Medical Clinic Project, which serves an entire village each month—reaching Hindus, Christians, and non-believers alike. While medical help is given by a doctor and nurse (with medicines we must purchase), inner healing is ministered throughout the day, bringing relief to pain, addictions, broken relationships, and many other afflictions.

On this front, Seelan Singham from our JHC committee has kindly stepped forward to help with travel and van hire expenses for the medical and JAK staff. In addition, Dr. Gowri Sethu -Physician and author from Chennai, has begun exploring ways to send medicines from India



As part of the succession plan:

1. I have begun forming a "Friends of Jesuran" network in Sri Lanka to mentor and journey with JAK. I have approached Rev. Dr. Chrisso Handy, Chairman of AOG Colombo, to guide this initiative.
2. In divine timing, Ps. Pitchaia from New Life Christ Ministries, Salem (India) has come forward to work alongside Jesuran to strengthen the Inner Healing foundation in Jaffna.




3. An invitation to take the Jesuran Inner Healing to India has been given

Bringing Healing and Hope to Broken Communities

On the 6th of October 2025, through the compassionate initiative of Jesuran Healing Center, we conducted a medical camp in Maavai Kalatti SenthezhuPuram, an unknown village located near the coastal region of Keerimalai. This village has long suffered from the devastating effects of war and continues to struggle with numerous challenges even today. The people face severe shortages of clean water, lack of proper housing, extreme poverty, and the hardship of both men and women working as daily laborers to survive. Addiction to alcohol and betel chewing, lack of education, poor hygiene, and unhealthy lifestyles are common in their daily lives. Many children drop out of school at a young age to join their parents in labor, continuing a generational cycle of bondage and poverty. Among parents, there is a lack of interest in education, moral discipline is low, and despite having some available resources in the area, there is little initiative or effort to use them effectively.

The people of Keerimalai suffer not only from physical illnesses but also from emotional pain, deep trauma, and educational neglect, leaving them broken both spiritually and mentally. During our medical camp, we provided

essential medical care along with inner healing through prayer and words of encouragement. Dr. Alfred Cruz served with great dedication, and Nurse Mohana assisted with deep compassion.

More than 50 individuals came forward to receive treatment and prayer. In those moments, we witnessed the Holy Spirit touching hearts and healing broken souls. In this forgotten village of Maavai Kalatti SenthezhuPuram, we saw the grace of God revealed — sowing seeds of hope and healing among the people, which stands as a powerful testimony for us.


A Child Strengthened by God's Love
