RESTORING HOPE BEYOND BOUNDARIES

By the abundant grace of God, a Medical Outreach and Inner Healing Ministry were successfully conducted on 31 July 2026 in Karainagar Oori (G/S Division: J44).

Karainagar Oori is an underdeveloped coastal village home to approximately 200 to 250 families, predominantly of the Hindu faith. The community relies almost entirely on sea fishing for their daily livelihood. Despite their tireless labor, the village faces severe socio-economic, structural, and social hardships. Access to clean drinking water is a daily struggle, and basic housing infrastructure is critically lacking, with many families living without proper homes, toilets, or washroom facilities.

Furthermore, the village suffers from extreme isolation. Essential facilities such as hospitals, pharmacies, and markets are located over 15 kilometers away, making healthcare and basic necessities extremely difficult to access due to the lack of proper public transportation. Educational opportunities are severely limited, with no nearby schools or tuition classes available for children. These systemic struggles have led to pressing social challenges within the village, including early marriages and rising drug abuse among youth.

In the midst of these heavy realities, our team stepped in to bring holistic care, medical relief, and spiritual comfort. We were deeply blessed by the dedicated service of Dr. Camilas (SHO - MBBS) and Nurse Mohana, who served compassionately throughout the day. They offered patient medical consultations, listened attentively to health concerns, and provided essential care to individuals who rarely have access to medical professionals. By the end of the day, 82 beneficiaries received vital medical treatment and consultations.

Alongside the medical services, the Inner Healing Ministry provided a quiet, compassionate space for the villagers to lay down their heavy burdens, emotional wounds, and daily anxieties before the Lord. Through prayer and loving encouragement, many experienced deep inner peace, comfort, and renewed spiritual strength.

This outreach was a powerful testament that God has not forgotten the people of Karainagar Oori. Even in a community marked by deep poverty, isolation, and lack of basic resources, the love and compassion of Christ were tangibly experienced.

We express our deepest gratitude to Dr. Camilas (SHO - MBBS), Nurse Mohana, and all our faithful prayer partners and supporters whose generosity and commitment made this outreach possible. We continue to pray that God will bring lasting transformation, restoration, and hope to every family in Karainagar Oori.



IN HEARTS THAT FELT ABANDONED, GOD POURED OUT HIS UNFAILING LOVE ONCE AGAIN



By the abundant grace and unfailing faithfulness of God, the Jesuran Healing Center was blessed to conduct a Medical Camp and Inner Healing Ministry on 29 July 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., at Menik Farm - 4th Unit, located approximately 37 kilometres from Vavuniya Town, within the Vengalcheddikulam Division (GS Division 207 - Aandiyapuliyankulam).

Menik Farm is home to nearly 2,000 families, including approximately 300 Christian families and 10 NRC Churches. The majority of the community follows the Hindu faith, and most families depend on daily wage labour as their primary source of income.

The people of this village continue to face many hardships. The community has been significantly affected by repeated flooding, and many families are still rebuilding their lives. Limited access to clean drinking water, early marriages, increasing drug abuse, a growing number of female-headed households, and limited educational opportunities remain ongoing challenges. In addition, the nearest hospital is approximately 20 kilometres away, making even basic medical care difficult to access for many families.

In the midst of these needs, God once again revealed His love and compassion. Dr. Mithira and Nurse Mohana faithfully served throughout the entire day with genuine kindness, patience, and dedication. Every patient was welcomed with care, listened to with compassion, and provided with the medical attention and treatment they needed. Their servant-hearted ministry became a true blessing to the community.

By the end of the day, 102 people had received medical consultations, treatment, and essential medicines. For many, this was far more than a medical clinic—it was a reminder that God has not forgotten them. Through the loving care they received, many experienced the compassion and hope of Christ in a very personal way.

Alongside the medical services, the Inner Healing Ministry deeply touched many lives. As individuals brought their emotional wounds, painful memories, family burdens, and broken hearts before the Lord in prayer, they experienced His peace, comfort, and renewed hope. It was a beautiful reminder that God desires to heal not only our physical bodies but also the hidden wounds of our hearts.

One of the most encouraging moments of the outreach came through a local Foursquare Church Pastor. After witnessing the impact of the Inner Healing Ministry, he expressed a strong desire to learn more about this life-transforming ministry. He shared that he would encourage and send fellow pastors to the Jesuran Healing Center to receive training in Inner Healing so that they, too, could minister healing and restoration within their own churches and communities. We believe this is a wonderful opportunity that God is opening to expand this ministry and equip more leaders for His Kingdom.

This outreach reminded us once again that God's love never overlooks a community in need. Even in places where hope seems distant, He faithfully sends His people at the right time to bring healing, encouragement, and the love of Christ. Through this ministry, many experienced not only physical care but also the assurance that they are deeply loved and never forgotten by God.

We continue to pray that the Lord will richly bless every family in Menik Farm with good health, lasting peace, renewed hope, and transformed lives. May He strengthen the local churches and continue to open doors for His healing ministry to reach many more communities across Sri Lanka.

Our heartfelt gratitude goes to Dr. Mithira and Nurse Mohana for their faithful and compassionate service. We also extend our deepest appreciation to all our generous donors whose prayers, financial support, and partnership made this outreach possible.

Because of your faithful giving and unwavering commitment, another community experienced the love and compassion of Christ. Your generosity brought medical care to the sick, comfort to the brokenhearted, and hope to those who needed it most. 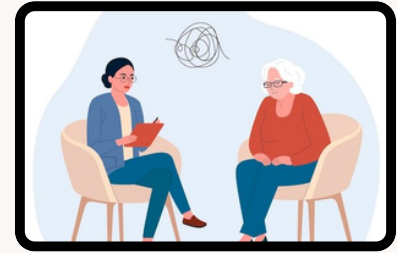

From Heavy Burdens to Heavenly Peace

At 72 years of age, this father lives completely alone after his marriage responsibilities have passed. Due to old age, various physical ailments and health conditions began to affect his body, leaving him physically weak and distressed.



Along with his failing health, severe financial hardships and the burden of isolation left him deeply anxious and emotionally broken. Overwhelmed by physical pain, financial struggles, and loneliness, he approached us with a heavily burdened heart.

During our time with him, he was lovingly counseled and encouraged through God's Word. An inner healing prayer ministry was conducted, helping him surrender all his hurts, fears, and financial worries into the hands of the Lord.

Through prayer, he experienced profound comfort, renewed hope, and divine inner peace. Touched by God's love and grace, he left with a refreshed spirit and renewed strength to face the challenges of life ahead.

Restored in God's Love Amidst Rejection



At 32 years of age, this sister was married three years ago through an arranged marriage set by her parents. However, as they remained childless, she faced immense emotional distress, painful words, and pressure from her in-laws. With her husband constantly siding with his family, a deep distance grew between them, leading to abandonment and a divorce case that is currently ongoing in court.

Overwhelmed by the painful circumstances in her marital life, she was deeply heartbroken. To make her situation harder, she found herself with no one to support, care for, or help her during this critical time of isolation.

During our visit, she was lovingly counselled and encouraged with God's comforting Word. An inner healing prayer ministry was conducted, guiding her to surrender all her deep wounds, fears, rejection, and emotional burdens into the hands of the Lord.

Through prayer, she experienced divine peace, profound comfort, and a renewed sense of hope. Reassured by God's unfailing love that He will never leave her nor forsake her, she left with a refreshed spirit and renewed strength to face her legal battles and future with confidence.

Healing and Hope Beyond Pain and Betrayal

At 40 years of age, this sister has been married for over 10 years. Having no children, her marital life was deeply troubled due to her husband's unfaithfulness and extramarital affairs. Beyond the emotional pain, she was subjected to severe physical abuse and domestic violence by her husband, leaving her with both physical injuries and deep emotional scars.



Having endured years of cruelty, she has now taken the courageous step to seek a divorce and walk away from this toxic relationship. Overwhelmed by physical suffering, betrayal, and deep heartbreak, she approached us carrying immense emotional burdens.

During our visit, she was lovingly counselled and encouraged through God's Word. An inner healing prayer ministry was conducted, creating a space for her to surrender all her trauma, fears, physical pain, and bitterness into the hands of the Lord.

Through this powerful time of prayer, she experienced profound inner healing, God's peace, and a renewed sense of dignity and hope. Delivered from the weight of her past trauma, she left with a refreshed spirit and divine strength to move forward with her legal process and embrace her future.



Strength and Healing for the Pastoral Journey

This young minister serves faithfully in the Lord's vineyard. He was married recently, but as his mother and sister were not fully supportive of the marriage, conflicts soon arose between his wife and his family. Being caught in the middle of these family disputes left him deeply distressed and emotionally burdened.

Furthermore, his wife had carried deep trauma, hardships, and painful experiences from her childhood, the impacts of which added further complexity to their marriage. Balancing these domestic struggles, a challenging ministry, and severe financial distress left this young pastor feeling overwhelmed.

During our time with him, he was lovingly counselled, encouraged through the Scriptures, and ministered to through an inner healing prayer session. He was enabled to surrender all his family hurt, emotional exhaustion, ministerial burdens, and financial worries into the hands of the Lord.

Through this powerful time of prayer, he experienced divine peace, spiritual strength, and a renewed conviction. Touched by God's grace, he left with a refreshed spirit and renewed perseverance to foster harmony at home, overcome financial hurdles, and carry forward his ministry with boldness.

Restoring Joy and Self-Worth in a Young Heart

At just 12 years of age, this young boy has carried deep emotional scars caused by rejection and body-shaming within his own home. Because of his darker skin tone, he was constantly mocked and teased by his siblings, which led to frequent conflicts at home. Unable to manage the situation, his family sent him away to live with his grandparents, where he now continues his schooling away from his parents.



Being rejected by his own family and ridiculed for his appearance left him with a deep sense of insecurity, low self-esteem, and emotional trauma. The pain of separation from his parents and the burden of rejection weighed heavily on his young mind.

During our visit, he was lovingly counselled and reminded of how precious and uniquely made he is in the eyes of God. An inner healing prayer ministry was conducted, helping him release the bitterness, feelings of inadequacy, and pain of rejection into the Lord's hands.

Through prayer, he experienced divine comfort, restored joy, and a renewed sense of self-worth. Delivered from the emotional wounds of his past, he left with a refreshed spirit, restored confidence, and a hopeful outlook toward his education and future.



Faith and Peace Amidst Sudden Illness and Hardship

At 42 years of age, this brother faced a sudden crisis when, just three months ago, he experienced a severe weakness/paralysis below his knees, making it extremely difficult for him to walk or perform daily tasks.

Compounding his physical ailment, his family has been struggling with severe poverty and financial hardship. Unable to earn a livelihood or cover medical expenses, the weight of his illness combined with economic distress left him deeply anxious, emotionally shattered, and worried about his family's future.

During our visit, he was lovingly counselled and encouraged through God's comforting Word. An inner healing prayer ministry was conducted, guiding him to surrender all his physical pain, financial worries, and emotional distress into the hands of the Lord.

Through prayer, he experienced profound divine peace, comfort, and a renewed sense of hope. Reassured that God is his strength in times of weakness, he left with a refreshed spirit and renewed faith to face his health and financial challenges.

Finding Hope and Peace Amidst Longing and Waiting

At 30 years of age, this brother and his wife have been married for five years. However, remain childless after years of waiting, which has brought deep emotional distress to their lives. In particular, his wife, Nivetha, has been suffering from extreme anxiety, emotional heartbreak, and mental burden due to their long wait for a child and societal pressure.



Overwhelmed by the pain of waiting, fear of the future, and emotional exhaustion, they approached us with heavily burdened hearts.

During our visit, they were lovingly counselled and encouraged through God's comforting Word. An inner healing prayer session was conducted, creating a sacred space especially for sister Nivetha to surrender all her emotional wounds, anxiety, deep pain, and fears into the hands of the Lord.

Through prayer, they experienced divine comfort, profound inner peace, and a renewed sense of hope. Reassured of God's faithful love in their period of waiting, they left with a refreshed spirit and renewed strength to face the days ahead with confidence.
