# FREE MOBILE MEDICAL CAMP



## A TOUCH OF HOPE IN A FORGOTTEN VILLAGE

As part of the compassionate ministry of the Jesuran Healing Center, a medical camp and outreach service was conducted on April 22, 2026, in Maruthapuram, Karainagar (J/40). This area is predominantly inhabited by Hindu families, with around 300 households residing in the community.

As it was our first visit to this village, we were deeply moved by the living conditions and the many struggles faced by the people. This experience placed a strong burden in our hearts to share God's love and care with them.

The village faces significant social and economic challenges. Around 30 widows and 175 children live in this community. Most families depend on fishing and daily wage labor for survival. However, the lack of medical facilities, limited transportation, and the shortage of clean drinking water (salty water issue) make daily life extremely difficult.

In addition, there is a lack of awareness regarding the importance of education. Some children leave school at a young age to support their families through labor. Early marriages and substance abuse are also concerns affecting the community. Conflicts between nearby villages further hinder social harmony and development.

In such circumstances, the people needed not only physical healing but also inner comfort and hope. During this medical camp, 65 individuals participated and received medical care along with prayer support. Many opened their hearts and shared the struggles and burdens they carry in their daily lives.

Through this service, 6 families experienced salvation, which stands as a powerful testimony of God's grace. During moments of prayer and encouragement, we witnessed many hearts being touched by His love.

This outreach reminded us that even in villages like Maruthapuram, Karainagar—often overlooked—the grace of God is still at work. Small acts of love and compassion can plant seeds of hope in the lives of people. This experience continues to inspire us to serve with greater faith, love, and compassion.

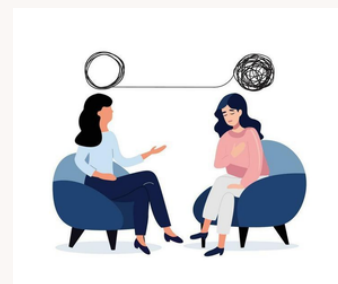
Their elder sister continues her education while staying in a hostel. Though physically distant, her heart constantly longs for her younger brothers.

## A Mother Searching for Hope

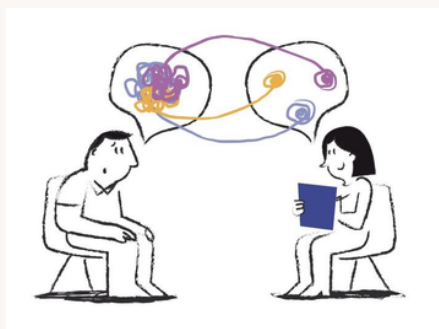
