On 20.03.2026, meetings will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon at Calvary Full Gospel Church, Kokuvil. On the same day, another meeting will take place from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at St. Peter's Methodist Church, Jaffna. On 21.03.2026, a meeting will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon at The Way of Life Missionary Church in Chundikuli. Later that day, from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., a meeting will be conducted at a church in the Sappattai area, bringing together people from the Vadamarachchi and Thenmarachchi regions. On 22.03.2026, meetings will be held at The Way of Life Missionary Church and at the Viduthalai Prayer House Church. Finally, on 23.03.2026, meetings covering the Kilinochchi and Mullaitivu districts will be held in the Puthukkudiyiruppu area, for which all arrangements have already been made.

We continue to pray and look forward with expectation that during these days God's grace will touch hearts and bring renewed hope, peace, and spiritual revival to many lives.



FREE MEDICAL CAMP

Where pain once lived, God
planted hope.



On February 6, 2026, as a continuation of the compassionate ministry of Jesuran Healing Center, a second medical camp was conducted in Maavai Kalatti SenthezhuPuram, a small and often forgotten village located near the coastal region of Keerimalai. When we first visited this place, the pain and needs we witnessed deeply touched our hearts. Feeling God's call to return and serve these people again, this second outreach was prayerfully organized.

This village has been carrying the wounds of war for many years. Many families are still living under the heavy burden of poverty. The shortage of clean drinking water, lack of safe housing, and the daily struggle to meet even the most basic needs make life extremely difficult for the people. Most families survive only through hard daily labor.

Socially too, the community faces many challenges. The importance of education is still not fully recognized by many. Some children leave school at a very young age to work alongside their parents as laborers. In addition, habits such as alcohol consumption and betel chewing continue to affect many lives, slowing down the progress of the community.

In such circumstances, the people needed not only physical treatment but also inner comfort and hope. During the medical camp, we provided medical care for physical illnesses and also spent time praying with them, sharing words of encouragement and God's love. In those moments, many people opened their hearts and shared the struggles and pain they carry in their daily lives.

In this service, Dr. Alfred Cruz served with great dedication and compassion by providing medical treatment. Nurse Mohana assisted with patience and a heart full of kindness. More than 50 people received medical care and prayer during the camp. In those precious moments, we witnessed the Holy Spirit touching hearts and bringing comfort and renewal to many broken lives.

In this seemingly forgotten village of Maavai Kalatti SenthezhuPuram, this outreach reminded us that the grace of God is still at work. Through small acts of love and care, seeds of hope can be planted in the lives of people. This experience became a powerful testimony for us and continues to encourage us to serve with faith and compassion.

Touched by Grace, Restored by Healing

A 45-year-old ministry worker came to us with deep sorrow because of a difficult situation in his family. It has been only one year since his marriage, but his wife is currently struggling with mental health challenges. She often appears physically weak, confused, and emotionally distressed. She finds it difficult to carry out even basic household tasks and lacks the motivation to do daily activities.



At times, she insists that her husband must take care of all her responsibilities and needs, reflecting a troubled and unsettled state of mind.

Burdened by this painful situation, the ministry worker approached us seeking help and guidance. With compassion and care, inner healing ministry was conducted for him. During that time, we prayed with him and interceded that God's peace and comfort would touch his heart. We also encouraged him to hold on to faith, believing that God would bring healing, restoration, and renewal into his family.

God heals the deepest wounds and restores broken families.



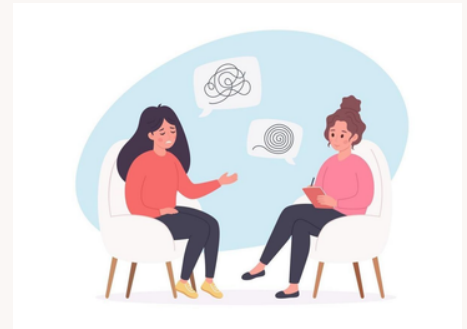
This mother, who has four children, came to us carrying deep pain and distress about her family situation. Her eldest son had been emotionally hurt through certain experiences with church workers, and about three years ago he left home and moved into a very different and troubled path in life. At present, he is wandering in a disturbed state, believed to be under the strong influence of an unclean spirit, which has brought great sorrow and struggle to the entire family.

Because of this painful situation, the whole family is living in deep grief and uncertainty. This mother in particular carries a heavy emotional burden as she faces the difficult challenge of her children's lives and future.

When she came to us seeking help, Inner Healing ministry was conducted for her with compassion and care. During that time, we prayed for her, asking God to touch her wounded heart, bring comfort and peace to her life, and restore her family through His healing power.

A Life Touched by Pain, Yet Held by God's Grace

This sister has two children. Her eldest daughter is married and has a five-year-old daughter. However, due to the harsh behavior of her husband and the difficult family circumstances, the daughter is living a life filled with hardship and emotional pain. Because of this situation, the sister and her son are currently living together with her daughter's family.



About sixteen years ago, her husband abandoned her and their two children and went away after marrying another woman. This painful incident left deep emotional wounds in their lives. Since then, this sister and her daughter have been carrying many burdens and emotional struggles in their daily lives, trying to move forward despite the hardships they face.

In particular, her 16-year-old son has been deeply affected by the behavior of his brother-in-law and is living with great mental distress. In the midst of such pain and brokenness, by the grace and mercy of the Lord, a healing ministry was conducted for this sister, bringing hope and comfort to her life.

Healing for a Heart Carrying Long Years of Pain



This sister is currently 45 years old. She lost her father at a very young age, and the pain of that loss still remains as a deep wound in her heart. At the same time, due to poverty and difficult family circumstances, she has remained unmarried until now. She is currently living with her mother and younger brother.

Carrying many burdens and emotional struggles in her life, this sister has continued to endure these hardships. By the grace of the Lord, an inner healing ministry was conducted for her, bringing comfort and hope to her heart.

Even in the midst of hardship, we pray that God will guide and protect these young lives with hope and love.

These are two young boys, one aged 14 and the other 12. Five years ago, their beloved mother passed away, leaving a deep emptiness in their lives. Growing up without the love and protection of a mother, they now live without anyone to properly guide and care for them. It also appears that their father is unable to show full responsibility or concern for them.

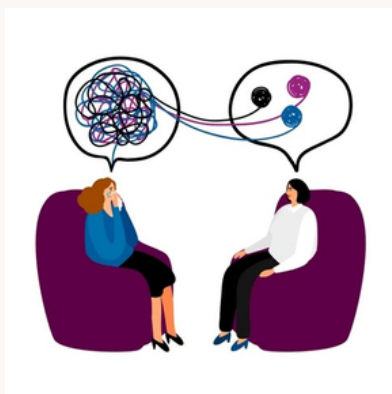


As a result, these young boys are facing many challenges in life, struggling with loneliness and emotional pain at such a tender age. Although they are currently under the care of a relative, the burdens of life weigh heavily on them even in their childhood.

Because of poverty, financial difficulties, and challenging family circumstances, continuing their education has become very difficult. They also have a sister who is 16 years old and currently staying in a hostel while trying to continue her studies. The situation of these three children—struggling with the absence of their mother and the hardships within their family—is truly heartbreaking.

In this painful situation, a healing ministry was conducted for them, and heartfelt prayers were offered so that they may receive comfort and hope. It was prayed that God would guide their lives, protect them, and fill their future with hope and blessings.

Finding comfort in God even in the deepest loss.



He is currently 72 years old. A few months ago, his beloved wife, who had been the foundation of his life, suddenly passed away after falling ill. This loss has left a deep wound in his heart. After losing the companion who stood beside him for many years, he now spends his days in profound loneliness and indescribable sorrow. Every corner of his home reminds him of his wife, making the emptiness even more painful to bear.
