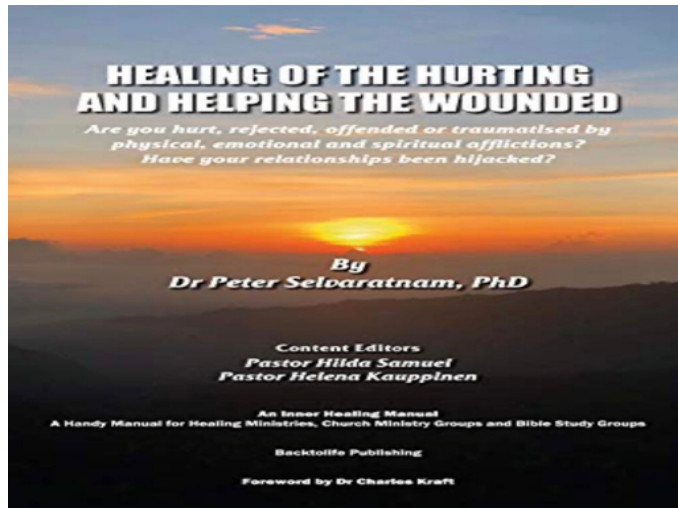
Dr. Peter Selvaratnam Inner Healing Book

Where Healing Meets Hope, A Day of Care and Restoration in Alayampadi

On January 29, 2026, through the ministry of Jesuran Healing Center, a free mobile medical service was carried out in the small village of "Alayampadi," which comes under the Tellippalai Pradeshiya Sabha.

This village has faced many setbacks due to the war in the past and is currently in the process of gradual recovery. Approximately 150 families live in this community. The lives of the people here are filled with various forms of emotional wounds and deep pain.

Most of the residents are trapped in poverty, earning their livelihood through daily wage labor. The village also has a significant number of female-headed households. Children in this community are experiencing a noticeable setback in their educational development.

In this context, the free medical camp conducted by Jesuran Healing Center proved to be of great benefit to the villagers. Our doctor, Dr. Alfred Cruz, along with Nurse Mohan, rendered excellent and dedicated service. Around 40 individuals participated in this medical camp and received medical consultation and treatment.

However, this camp was not limited to physical treatment alone; it became a deep and meaningful ministry beyond that. Our team served the people through prayer and inner healing ministry. We laid hands on the sick, prayed for them, spoke words of life, and declared hope over the land.

At that moment, tears flowed—not merely because of physical illness, but because people released the pain and suffering they had carried in their hearts for many years and received comfort and peace.

This medical camp went beyond being a simple humanitarian effort; it was a prophetic declaration. This land has not been forgotten. These people have not been abandoned.

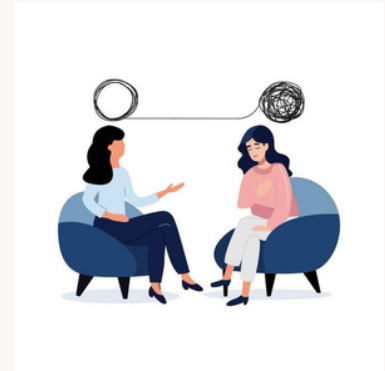

Healing Encounters at the Heart of Grace

When Grace Heals the Heart.

A is currently 31 years old, a devoted mother of two children, who for years carried silent tears and unspoken pain deep within her heart. Due to ongoing marital conflicts, her husband left her, forcing her to face a life marked by loneliness, insecurity, and lack of love and protection.

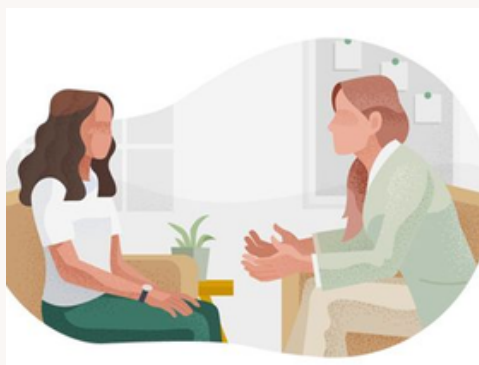


The absence of her husband's wholehearted love and support deeply wounded her heart. Each day, emotional scars, inner anguish, and financial hardship pressed heavily upon her life.

In this broken season, a healing ministry was carried out for her. During those sacred moments of prayer, God embraced her where people had walked away. He saw her tears, and His grace gently touched her heart, bringing healing to the long-carried burdens and deep brokenness within her.

Today, in place of pain she has received hope; in place of loneliness, comfort; and in place of a shattered life, renewed strength. She now moves forward with courage, upheld by the peace and grace of God.

A Healing Encounter Amid Pain and Uncertainty



B carried an overwhelming burden on her heart due to her husband's severe illness. Each day was filled with unspeakable sorrow and deep anxiety as she watched the suffering of the one she loves. The fear surrounding continuous medical treatment and the uncertainty of what tomorrow might bring wounded her heart profoundly.

As the family's stable income was disrupted, ongoing financial hardship added to her emotional distress. Unable to share her pain with anyone, she bore the heavy responsibility of holding her family together, facing both day and night with silent tears and quiet strength.

In this broken and vulnerable state, a healing ministry was carried out for her.

From Silent Tears to Renewed Hope.

C is currently 12 years old. With her parents having lived separately for the past 10 years, the unbearable pain of loneliness and loss settled deeply in her heart from a very young age. At a time when she needed love, care, and protection, the negative experiences she endured shattered her inner world, leaving her to live with unspoken fear, confusion, and deep sorrow.



Often unable to express her pain through words, it flowed only as tears. The silent burdens that accumulated in her young heart left her deeply affected emotionally.

It was in this broken state that an inner healing ministry was carried out for her. During those moments of prayer, God's love gently touched the hidden wounds she had carried for so long, and comfort and peace began to fill her heart. In place of pain, hope was born; in place of fear, calm and assurance began to rise. Today, she is slowly beginning to sense a new light and renewed hope for life, emerging from behind the tears she once carried.

A Mother's Heavy Burden Met by Healing Grace.



G has a 35-year-old son who is affected by mental illness. Caring for him and ensuring his safety on her own each day has become a great life-long struggle for this mother. The fear surrounding her son's condition, constant worry about the future, and the unceasing weight of responsibility have deeply wounded her heart. Unspoken anxieties and silent tears have become a part of her daily life.

In this condition, an inner healing ministry was carried out for her. Through prayer, God's grace gently touched the emotional burdens and wounds she had carried for a long time, allowing comfort and renewed strength to begin to rise within her heart.

Even in this season of heavy burdens, they are not alone.

D & E They have no children. Even in their advanced age—at a stage of life that should have been a time of rest—they are fighting daily battles with multiple illnesses.



Having relied only on each other for support, their lives were suddenly shaken when the husband was unexpectedly struck by illness and suffered a stroke, turning their world upside down. That unforeseen moment deeply shook their hope and inner strength.

It is not only the pain of physical weakness they endure, but also the haunting fear of “What will happen tomorrow?” The loneliness that comes from having no children, combined with deep anxiety about the future, has crushed their hearts.

Amid ongoing health challenges, mounting medical burdens, and the heavy pressures of life, they now live carrying unspeakable emotional distress and deep inner pain, struggling through each day with great difficulty and endurance.

Carrying Unseen Pain, Touched by Inner Healing Grace.



Fs life today is filled with continuous trials. Her husband has been affected by a stroke and is unable to go to work, remaining confined to the home. The shoulders that once carried the family have now grown weak, and the entire responsibility of the household rests on F alone.

While she works daily as a wage laborer to sustain the family, it is not physical exhaustion but emotional weariness that she carries most heavily.

Adding to this pain, five years ago, the sudden death of their 28-year-old daughter became an unhealed wound etched deeply into F's life. Even today, the loss of her daughter flows as silent tears within her heart. The death of her child, ongoing poverty, and her husband's long-term illness have all combined to leave F living each day with deep emotional wounds and profound inner sorrow. In this condition, an inner healing ministry was carried out for her.

When Fear Overwhelms the Heart, Healing Must Begin Within

When doctors confirmed that she has cancer, it felt as though her life came to a sudden standstill. Unable to accept the news, her heart became overwhelmed with deep fear, anxiety, and confusion. The very word cancer caused her inner world to tremble, filling her mind with the fear of death.



Although she says, "I do not want to die," her reluctance to undergo treatment reveals the depth of her wounded heart and broken emotional state.

More than the physical pain of the illness, it is the weight of the diagnosis itself that has deeply wounded her. Fear of the future, constant thoughts of "what will happen to me," and a sense of hopeless isolation have left her living with profound inner sorrow and emotional distress. In this condition, it has become clear that her heart needs healing before her body can find strength.
