A pessimist said, "Things will get worse."

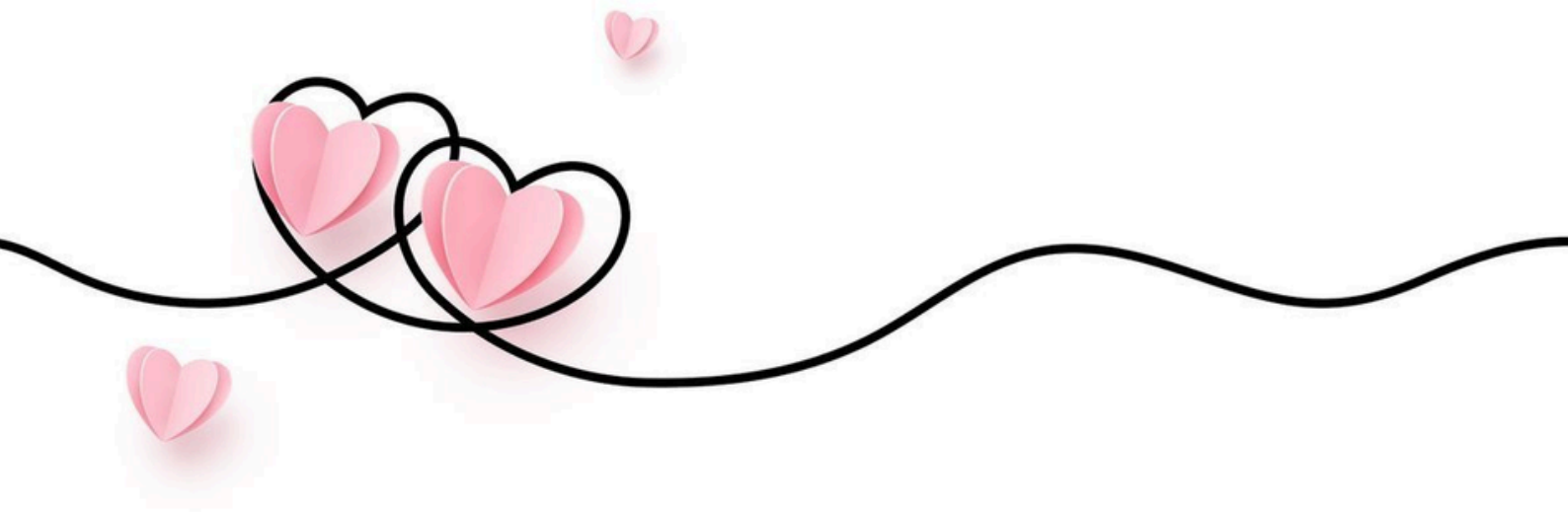
A politician stopped, gave a grand speech, promised new laws and better roads so no one would fall into a pit again—and then walked away.

FREE MOBILE MEDICAL CAMP



BRINGING HEALING, HOPE, AND COMPASSION TO A COMMUNITY IN NEED

On May 13, 2026, as part of the compassionate ministry of the Jesuran Healing Center, a Medical Camp and Inner Healing Ministry were successfully conducted in Udayapuram Village (GN Divisions J/89 and J/90) in the Jaffna District.

Udayapuram is home to approximately 250 families. Many of the residents face economic hardships and have limited access to educational and social resources. Due to the village's distance from Jaffna town, people often have to travel to the Jaffna Teaching Hospital even for urgent medical needs. The majority of families in the area depend on fishing as their primary source of livelihood.

The village is also home to nearly 30 individuals with special needs, along with their families, who continue to face significant medical, social, and emotional challenges.

A total of 65 people participated in the Medical Camp and received medical consultations and treatment. We are grateful for the dedicated service of Dr. Alfred Cruz and Nurse Mohana, who ministered to the community with compassion and professional care.

In addition to the medical services, the Inner Healing Ministry was a great blessing to many. Participants experienced emotional healing, comfort, and renewed hope as they brought their burdens, wounds, and struggles before the Lord.

This outreach served as a powerful reminder that God has not forgotten Udayapuram. Through His love and mercy, He touched the lives of the people, bringing healing to their bodies, minds, and spirits. We continue to pray that the Lord will strengthen this community and bring lasting transformation, hope, and blessings to every family.



TRANSFORMING LIVES THROUGH LOVE AND CARE

As part of the compassionate ministry of the Jesuran Healing Center, a medical camp and outreach service were conducted on May 29, 2026, in Pallikuda Village (GN Division KN/65), located in the Poonakary area of Kilinochchi District

This village is home to approximately 700 families, the majority of whom belong to the Catholic faith. Around 120 Christian families also reside within the community. Although many years have passed since the end of the war, the people of this area continue to live with its lasting effects, facing numerous social and economic hardships.

The medical camp was conducted with the valuable service of Dr. Alfred Cruz and Nurse Mohana. More than 50 people attended the program and received medical consultations, treatment, and health advice. Alongside the medical services, prayer and words of encouragement were shared, bringing comfort and hope to many

During our interaction with the villagers, we gained a deeper understanding of the challenges they face daily. The community struggles with limited access to clean drinking water due to salinity issues, inadequate housing conditions, low levels of educational awareness, and a lack of transportation facilities. The nearest hospital is located approximately 4 kilometers away, making access to healthcare difficult for many families

Fishing and agriculture are the primary sources of livelihood in the area. However, unstable income and limited opportunities leave many families vulnerable. Social issues such as early marriage, substance abuse, and child labor continue to affect the well-being and future of the younger generation

Yet, amidst these difficulties, one truth deeply touched our hearts: God has not forgotten Pallikuda. Despite the hardships and isolation experienced by this community, His love and grace continue to reach the people. This medical outreach served as a powerful reminder that God is still at work in places that are often overlooked.

The gratitude expressed by the villagers, the prayers they shared, and the hope reflected on their faces were among the greatest blessings of this ministry. It reminded us that even simple acts of love and compassion can bring light into people's lives and plant seeds of hope for the future.

Jesuran Healing Center remains committed to praying for and serving the people of Pallikuda through medical, social, and spiritual support. We trust that the Lord will continue to bless this community, bringing healing, restoration, and renewed hope to every family.

Through God's provision and the generous support of Transformation Church, Glen Waverley, JAK (The Jaffna Healing Centre) was able to expand its Humanitarian Medical Mobile Clinic outreach.

Instead of one Mobile medical clinic a month in Jaffna peninsula only this support enabled us to reach an additional village in the same month in the Northern Province. We are so grateful that we can reach two villages a month reaching hundreds of souls .

We sincerely thank Pastors George and Christina Kanagasabai, together with the Missions Board of Transformation Church, for their faithful prayers, partnership, and financial support, which continue to make this vital ministry possible.

From Emotional Wounds to a New Path of Hope



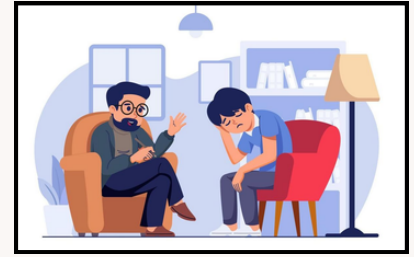

This family has two children, and their eldest son is now 26 years old. Although he once pursued his education and had hopes for a promising future, he gradually became heavily involved in mobile phone use and online gaming, eventually developing an addiction.

As a result, he discontinued his studies and remains at home without employment, spending most of his time day and night playing games on his phone. Despite the encouragement and advice of his family members, he has been unable to make positive changes, causing his life to stagnate without meaningful progress.

This situation has deeply affected his mother. Constantly worrying about her son's future, she has experienced prolonged emotional stress, which has contributed to her suffering from ulcers and left her in a physically and emotionally weakened condition. She continues to long for the day when her son will return to the right path and build a responsible and productive life. The ongoing struggles within the family have brought significant pain, uncertainty, and emotional burden, highlighting their need for comfort, support, and hope.

God's comfort restores wounded hearts.

She is 52 years old and has five children, all of whom are married and living separately with their own families. To support herself, she works as a daily wage laborer and strives to make a living despite many hardships.



At one point in her life, her husband deceived her and married another woman, leaving a deep emotional wound in her heart. This betrayal greatly affected her mental and emotional well-being, causing her to struggle with feelings of loneliness, rejection, and pain for many years.

In addition, her children are occupied with their own family responsibilities and are unable to provide the emotional support she longs for. The difficulties faced by one of her daughters in her married life have also become a source of great concern, adding to her emotional burden. These ongoing family struggles and disappointments left her feeling exhausted and overwhelmed.

During this difficult season, she received Inner Healing ministry, which gave her the opportunity to share the hurts and wounds she had carried for years. Hope begins to rise.



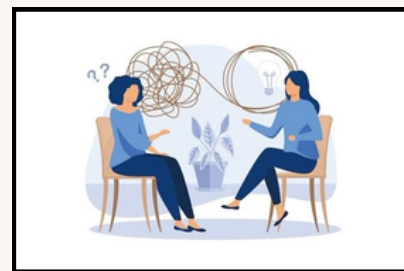
This young man is 23 years old. He is struggling with severe anger issues and an uncontrollable temperament, which has led him to face many problems in his life.

He lives with emotional instability and daily struggles, causing him great mental stress and distress. In addition, his physical health is also affected, and he suffers from various illnesses that further weaken him.

In the midst of all these challenges, he received Inner Healing ministry. Through this ministry, he was given the opportunity to express his inner pain and struggles. She and her eldest daughter were also severely injured but survived. Due to the injuries, her daughter had to undergo an amputation of one arm. Later, her father stayed with them for support, but he too was injured in another attack and passed away after some time.

Now she lives alone with her daughter, who has lost one arm. Despite experiencing immense loss and deep emotional pain, she continues to work as a daily wage laborer to sustain her livelihood.

In the midst of these continuous hardships and emotional struggles, she received Inner Healing ministry. Through this ministry, she was given the opportunity to share her deep wounds and pain. She experienced God's comfort and love, and has been strengthened with renewed hope and courage to move forward in her life.
